Micron hosted a roundtable discussion on theranostics clinical trials at its Osaka office. We welcomed Professor Seigo Kinuya of Kanazawa University, Professor Tadashi Watabe of The University of Osaka, and Professor Yoichi Shimizu of Kyoto University. The participants exchanged perspectives on the current state of clinical trials and the challenges facing the field.

The discussion covered practical topics essential to advancing radiopharmaceutical clinical trials, including the establishment and operation of in-house manufacturing facilities and radioisotope therapy rooms, workforce development, radiation safety management, and internal coordination when launching a new facility. Drawing on their respective experiences, the participants also spoke candidly about the operational challenges associated with radioisotope regulations, opportunities to streamline related processes, the advancement of investigator-initiated trials, and collaboration between trial sites and CROs.
